EARTH | the universe God made is ordered and good (vv. 4-7) ¹

SEA | evil has a limited place in God's world today (vv. 8-11) ²

DAWN | Sunrise tells us that evil will one day be destroyed (vv. 12-15) ³

OCEAN DEEP | The place of the dead is known to God (vv. 16-18) ⁴

LIGHT & DARKNESS | Good and evil are under God's control (vv. 19-21) ⁵

WEATHER | God's ways are very varied (v. 22-30, 34-38)

- ➤ God keeps snow and hail for times of trouble (vv. 22-24)
- ➤ God sends rain to water the desert (vv. 25-27)
- ➤ God is the creator of water in its different forms (vv. 28-30)
- ➤ God sends rain to water the dry ground (vv. 34-38)

STARS | God is sovereign over all spiritual powers (vv. 31-33)

➤ humble ourselves before God

- ¹ Then the LORD spoke to Job out of the storm. He said:
- ² "Who is this that obscures my plans with words without knowledge?
- ³ Brace yourself like a man; I will question you, and you shall answer me.
- ⁴ "Where were you when I laid the earth's foundation?

Tell me, if you understand.

⁵ Who marked off its dimensions? Surely you know!

Who stretched a measuring line across it?

- ⁶ On what were its footings set, or who laid its cornerstone—
- 7 while the morning stars sang together and all the angels^a shouted for joy?
- ⁸ "Who shut up the sea behind doors when it burst forth from the womb,
- ⁹ when I made the clouds its garment and wrapped it in thick darkness,
- when I fixed limits for it and set its doors and bars in place,
- ¹¹ when I said, 'This far you may come and no farther;

here is where your proud waves halt'?

 - or lead out the Bear with its cubs?
- ³³ Do you know the laws of the heavens? Can you set up God's dominion over the earth?
- 34 "Can you raise your voice to the clouds and cover yourself with a flood of water?
