What is the antidote to spiritual weariness?

You Reap What You Sow

(6:7-8)

⇒ the principle (v. 7)

- negatively & positively
- physically & spiritually

⇒ the application (v. 8)

- sowing to please the "flesh"
(the sinful human nature)
 - behaviour & beliefs
- sowing to please the "Spirit"
(the Holy Spirit of God)
 - behaviour & beliefs

- reaping destruction from the flesh
- reaping eternal life from the Spirit

What this isn't saying:

1. You must live the perfect life.
2. Everyone will be saved.
3. This is just karma.

How should we respond?

(6:9-10)

- keep doing good
- do not give up



Galatians 6:7-10

⁷ Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows.
⁸ Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. ⁹ Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. ¹⁰ Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.
